As property owner, tenant or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Kern County Public Health Services Department, Environmental Health Division (KCEHD), as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), for the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), will be holding an informational public hearing in compliance with Title 27 Section 21660 regarding proposed revisions to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Lost Hills Environmental Waste facility. The LEA is certified by CalRecycle to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Kern, including transfer stations, as well as all active and closed landfills.

#### Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The proposed revisions of the facility permit are for the Lost Hills Environmental Waste facility which currently operates under a Full Solid Waste Facility Permit, operated by H.M. Holloway. The Lost Hills Environmental Waste facility is located at 14045 Holloway Rd Lost Hills, CA 93249 within Kern County.

The purpose of the proposed Permit Revision for Lost Hills Environmental Waste Facility is to:

- Include new operations for a Material Recovery Facility.
- Include extension of estimated closure date due to recovery of landfill material.
- Include increased Permitted Maximum Tonnage and Traffic Volume per day.

The Kern County Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. CA-6 on November 7, 2023 regarding a conditional use permit to allow for the construction and operation of a treated auto-shredder waste material recovery facility at the existing Lost Hills Environmental Waste Facility located at 14045 Holloway Rd, Lost Hills CA, 93249, whereas the laws and regulations relating to the California Environmental Quality Act and the Kern County Planning and Natural Resources Department CEQA implementation procedures have been duly followed by facility staff.

#### Purpose of the Meeting

The Public Informational Hearing is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed revision of the Full Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWPF), and to provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed action. The decision to issue or not to issue the SWFP (revision, modified, or new) must be made within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete and correct as required by Statute. Prior to issuance of the revised solid waste facility permit, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from CalRecycle.

#### Disadvantaged Communities

This Public Informational Meeting will also serve to satisfy the requirements for a Disadvantaged Community Meeting in accordance with Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 21570(g)(3). For purposes of this requirement, "affected disadvantaged communities" are defined as those communities identified by the California Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to Section 39711 of the California Health and Safety Code that are located within one (1) mile of the facility. This meeting is intended to provide members of any such affected disadvantaged communities with the opportunity to receive information regarding the proposed facility revision, ask questions, and provide input.
